Modi govt destroying Constitution and co-operatives, fumes Sonia

Congress President Sonia Gandhi lodged a scathing attack on the BJP government at centre blaming it for undermining the constitution and its policies, which she said, is destroying the co-operative movements that forms the base for upliftment of the down trodden.

After inaugurating the memorial of former union home minister Shankarrao Chavan and unveiling his life-size statue here on Thursday, Sonia addressed a huge public meeting. While elaborating on the leadership qualities shown by the late Congress leader she said that he had a broad vision and always cared for the farmers. While reminding the audience that it was Shankarrao Chavan who first conceived the legislation that saved the tribal lands from going into the hands of non-tribals, she attacked the BJP government for undermining interests of tribals and farmers.

"It is very unfortunate that whatever welfare schemes for farmers, labourers, tribals, dalits, women, children and other weaker sections of the society that were conceived and implemented by the UPA government are being subverted by the BJP government and are being rendered useless causing a great inconvenience to

crores of people," she said.

"I'd like to remind the government that the farmers across the nation are distressed. They are fighting drought and they are committing suicides but the government is not doing anything for them. The government recently waived off thousands of crores of loans of the corporates but refused to waive off crop loans," she alleged.

Terming the co-operative movement as the conduit for upliftment of the weaker sections of the society, Sonia said that it is the need of the hour that the co-operative movement is strengthened again. "Instead, the BJP government is destroying the

movement. But, Congress will never allow the interests of the weaker sections of the society to be subdued," Sonia said.

She also charged the government for undermining the constitution.

"The power-hungry government toppled the state governments of Uttarakhand and Arunachal Pradesh by undermining the constitution and insulted the public mandate," Sonia said and thanked the Supreme Court for upholding the spirit of the constitution.

"In times like these we miss leaders like Shankarrao Chavan very much. He would not have tolerated dis-

grace to the constitution at all," she added. She also hailed him for his contribution as union home minister in resolving the problems in states like Punjab, Jammu and Kashmir and Mizoram and maintaining unity and integrity of the nation. She also described him as a person who was always dedicated to his ideals and honesty and said he was trusted by Indira and Rajiv for his qualities.

Former Prime Minister Dr Manmohan Singh remembered Chavan's initiatives as deputy chairman of the planning commission, while former union home ministers Sushilkumar Shinde and Shivraj Patil remembered his discipline and the way he groomed the younger party leadership.

Nanded MP and MPCC president Ashok Chavan in his welcome address described this as a great occasion for the the state Congress as well as his family as former Prime Minister Dr Manmohan Singh and party President Sonia Gandhi both attended the function together. Former Chief Ministers Prithviraj Chavan, Narayan Rane and Shivaji-rao Patil Nilangkar along, leader of opposition in the legislative assembly Radhakrishna Vikhe-Patil and MRCC chief Sanjay Nirupam were amongst the prominent leaders on the dais.

HC seeks State's reply over 'poor' security cover for semi-govt bodies

The Bombay High Court has directed the State government to file a reply in response to a public interest litigation (PIL) highlighting the 'sorry state' of the security personnel deployed at semi-governmental institutions in the city.

A division bench of Justice Vidyasagar Kanade and Justice Mahesh Sonak were hearing a petition filed by All Maharashtra Human Rights Welfare Association.

The petition challenges the inaction of the state government to successfully implement the recommendations of former Governor Ram Pradhan Committee, which passed the Maharashtra State Security Corporation Act in 2010. The Ram Pradhan Committee was formed to inspect the reasons behind the 26/11 Mumbai Terrorist attacks and accordingly the committee had given its find-

ings spelling out the recommendations required to be implemented to combat similar terrorist attacks in the future.

Post to the Committee's report, the state government had passed the said Act which deals with National as well as State security along with several other factors like recruitment, selection, training and service conditions of officers and members of the security force appointed under the said Act.

The petition states that based on the recommendations and the said Act, more than 3000 security personnel are recruited and are deployed at several governmental and semi-governmental institutions including private entities. The petition alleges that the corporation which was constituted to recruit the security force gives only Rs 10,000 as a salary to the security personnel, despite the Act provides payment of Rs 20,000 per month.

Monsoon saga continues, temp drops

The city on Wednesday received 6.5mm of rain in Colaba and 13.1 mm in Santacruz. The MCGM's Disaster Management Cell said that the island city has recorded 7.64 mm while the eastern suburbs and the western suburbs recorded 9.42mm and 6.41mm, respectively.

The city's temperature witnessed an average drop from 29.8 to 25.8 degree Celsius. No water-logging was reported giving a major respite to the city administration and citizens alike. Also, 13 cases of tree fall - three in the island city - two in the eastern suburbs and eight in the western

suburbs, were reported across the city with no injuries.

The Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai said that no short circuits were reported in the city with no one getting any injuries. A high tide is scheduled at 9.43 am of 3.29 metres and at 3.13 am of 2.32 meters on Friday.

Meanwhile, with the rise in lake levels, there has been a satisfactory increase in the total amount of water level in the seven lakes.

The Free Press Journal had previously reported that the city might not face more water cuts owing to the water levels in the lakes.

According to civic officials, if the water levels reach the required level then there will be no water cuts in the future. Interestingly, the total amount of water level in the seven reservoirs that feed the city, has rose to 6,66,272 million liters. Surprisingly, last year the total amount of water level recorded was 2,86,978 million liters.

Change in land use pattern due to urbanisation: TERI

The environment status report by The Energy and Resource Institute (TERI) has revealed a change in the land use pattern in Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR). It shows that there is a reduction in the share of agricultural and forests land by 7% and 5% respectively. MMR has three protected areas namely the Sanjay Gandhi National Park (SGNP), Karnala bird sanctuary and Tungareshwar and one eco-sensitive zone of Mahatheran within its limits. However, urbanisation has resulted in severe deforestation reducing the forest covers in the region.

According to the status report submitted by TERI, the forest cover of MMR accounted for almost 1142 sq km area in 1987 has now been reduced by around 225 sq.km, leading to an overall reduction by 5%.

Anjali Parasnis, Associate Director of TERI said, "There is a lack of planning process in the land use pattern by the authorities. The conservation of forest land is important to make it sustainable." The second highest change in land use has been recorded in the agricultural land under paddy cultivation in the highly ur-

banned areas of Thane, Vasai, Ambernath and Kalyan. The report says that the agricultural land is in tremendous stress as the owners of these lands usually sell or abandon the cultivable land for high economic values offered by the builders and developers which has led to conversion of agriculture land into Non-Agricultural plots.

The environment status report prepared by TERI was submitted to Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) in 2014 and was approved in 2016.

As a mitigation measure given by TERI, the land resources especially like forest and agricultural land were asked to avoid being used for construction purpose. "It is important for the authorities to mark the land resources like forest and agricultural land and conserve them", added Parasnis.
